The Center for Genomics and Bioinformatics at the Universidad Mayor (CGB-UM) seeks candidates for five full-time positions at the Assistant, Associate and Full Professor level (according to experience and achievements). Tenure track will be decided on an individual basis.

The CGB-UM host a total of 13 members engaged in collaborative research in genetics/genomics health, systems biology of model organisms, environmental microbiology and eco-genomics, applied genetics, computational genomics and bioinformatics. The center provides state-of-the-art research facilities with access to equipment for DNA sequencing, plant and animal production, high performance computing, advanced microscopy services, among others.

Applicants are required to have a Ph.D. degree in life sciences, biology, biochemistry, computer science, or related disciplines. Post-doctoral or comparable experiences are required. Candidates must have a proven and consistent track record of high-quality scientific publications and good communication skills.

Applicants at the Assistant Professor level must demonstrate ability to develop independent research and have had teaching experience. Applicants at the Associate Professor level must have a strong record of publications and extramural funding. For the case of Full Professors, the applicants must demonstrate an outstanding trajectory in research, mentorship at doctoral and postdoctoral levels, strong networks with national and international research centers and experience in scientific advisory panels (desirable). Preference will be given to applications that complement existing research lines and academic activities.
